Day Oncology Unit

The department works with other medical units at The Friendlies to provide patients with comprehensive cancer care. We have extensive experience in the diagnosis and treatment of most kinds

of cancer, including: Breast Cancer, Sarcomas, Melanoma, Kidney cancer, Ovarian cancer, Other gynecological cancers, Hepatoma, Biliary cancers, Pancreatic cancer, Neuroendocrine cancers and Leukemia.

Cardiac Services

The Friendlies leads the way in the Wide Bay region in the provision of comprehensive cardiology care. A topranking team of cardiologists, supported by a highly skilled team of clinical professionals and working with state-of-

the-art equipment enable the complete management of acute cardiac emergencies as well as the management of chronic conditions.

Through our Cath Lab, Critical Care Unit and Cardiac Inpatient Unit, patients have access to a full range of rhythm monitoring, haemodynamic pressure monitoring, angioplasty and pacemaker procedures without having to travel to a major centre.







Cath Lab

The Friendly Society Private Hospital is the only public or private facility between the Sunshine Coast and Townsville with a Cath Lab. Opened as part of a \$30million development and expansion, the Cath Lab is



equipped with the latest equipment. This means that people who experience a cardiac episode will have significantly improved health outcomes through access to early diagnosis and treatment.

Critical Care Unit

This nine-bed unit incorporates the specialties of a Coronary Care Unit and Intensive Care Unit. With 24 hour medical coverage, specialist nurses and advanced technology, the Critical Care Unit supports



the services of the hospital through the management of those patients with more complex treatment requirements.
