Podiatry Services

Our podiatrist treats medical conditions and injuries of the foot, ankle and lower limb. This can include skin and nail problems, foot and ankle injuries, foot complications and problems with gait or walking.

Our podiatrist can help with:

- General foot care; corns, callus, in-grown toenails
- Sports injuries sustained to the foot and ankle
- » Children's conditions; knee pain, heel pain, foot pain, footwear advice
- » Diabetic assessments, including checking your blood flow and blood pressures

- » Orthotic therapy
- » Footwear advice
- » Foot ulcer management
- » Nail surgery with local anaesthetic
- » Dry needling
- » Foot mobilisation
- » Low level laser therapy
- » NDIS assessment & treatment
