THE FRIENDLIES VIP CARD

The Friendlies has created a VIP Card to help patients make their choice of hospital known to other health professionals.

If you find yourself needing to be brought to hospital by the Queensland Ambulance Service, show this card to the staff treating you.

Dependant on your case, the Ambulance will bring you directly to The Friendlies for assessment and admission if required. Your paramedic will be the best healthcare professional to make this decision.



Please Note:

This card is to help you make your choice of hospital known to others. It does not allow for quicker treatment or admission once you are here. All patients at the Friendly Society Private Hospital are treated in timeframes based on their care needs.

OUR SERVICE

The Friendlies Emergency
Department is run by
experienced and compassionate
staff who are trained in providing
Emergency Care, and providing
both adult and paediatric
emergency services.

Our unit operates based on a Triage System, where a Triage nurse will prioritise care so the sickest patients are seen first.

Wait times are usually minimal, but patients are urged to see the Triage nurse if their symptoms get worse while they are waiting.

Once you have visited
The Friendlies Emergency
Department, we are able to send
a discharge letter to your GP,
so you can be assured of
continuity of care.

WILL THERE BE A COST?

The Friendlies Emergency Department is a private emergency facility.


Patients will need to provide a valid Medicare card and will incur an out-of-pocket free. Most patients can expect to pay a minimum of \$120.

A higher Emergency Department fee will need to be paid by patients without a Medicare card such as overseas visitors or those on a visa.

Radiology and Pathology providers may issue invoices to patients separately; however you may be eligible to claim some of these fees back from Medicare.

There will be no charge for DVA Gold Card holders or Worker's Compensation Insurance patients.

There is no out-of-pocket fee for review appointments, or if you present to emergency with the same condition within 7 days of your initial Emergency Department visit.
